



Tiny Paws Golden

This agreement (“**Agreement**”), dated as of February 21, 2021 (the “**Effective Date**”), is between Rebecca Degner (“**Breeder**”), and April Ivie (“**Buyer**”). The subject of this Agreement is the below-described puppy/dog (“**puppy/dog**”).

The dog subject to this Agreement is a miniature goldendoodle

Tiny paws Goldendoodles is excited that you have chosen us to provide you with your next family member. As with every family member it is important that we ensure the health and safety of them. To do just that we have outlined a few items below:

- 1.) The Buyer shall keep the dog as a household pet indoors.
- 2.) The Buyer shall provide the dog with an adequate food, fresh water, shelter, affection, and medical care upon sickness, disease, or injury.
- 3.) Maintenance should include an annual health exam and routine vaccinations as recommended by a board-certified veterinarian.
- 4.) A fully fenced yard or other humane means of exercise, such as daily walks. The dog shall not be kept chained or constantly outdoors. Never permit the dog to roam unattended
- 5.) The dog shall reside with the Buyer. The Buyer shall notify the Breeder immediately if the dog cannot be kept by the Buyer. The dog shall not be sold, transferred, or given to any individual or to any retail or wholesale establishment for the purpose of sale or resale to the public or to any research institution where medical experimentation or other practices take place.
- 6.) The Buyer and Breeder agree to keep each other informed of their current contact information.
- 7.) The Buyer agrees that it is the Buyer’s responsibility to accept the dog as described. The Breeder has provided and the Buyer has acknowledged a full disclosure of the health, habits, and temperament of the dog. The dog’s health records, from Animal Hospital of Fate, will be supplied at time of purchase.
- 8.) The Buyer may return the dog to the Breeder at any time and for any reason. At which time the breeder will work to place the puppy in a new home, the breeder will charge a \$500 rehoming fee and give any remaining funds received to the buyer up to the purchase price of the puppy.

- a. The Buyer agrees to return dog to the Breeder as sole owner of the dog in the event that buyer can no longer keep the dog.
 - b. We do understand that circumstances sometimes come up where a dog owner is no longer able to provide properly for his/her dog. Should the buyer not be able to provide adequate care for the dog, the dog must be returned to Tiny Paws Goldendoodles for re-homing.
 - c. If ownership is transferred without the knowledge of breeder this contract will be voided.
 - d. Never shall a Tiny Paws Goldendoodle dog be taken to an animal shelter to be rehomed. We are responsible breeders ensuring that all our dogs live in loving homes with owners who are able to provide for the social, physical, and mental well-being of their dogs.
- 9.) The Buyer agrees to provide basic obedience training for the dog, either with classes or at home. Basic obedience includes, but is not limited to: sit, stay, come, down, walking on a leash, crate and potty training.
- 10.) The buyer understands that Goldendoodles require a lot of maintenance and this can costly and time consuming but agrees to keep dog well-groomed at all times. The dog will need regular brushing to help keep coat from matting. Keep the coat well maintained and healthy.
- 11.) Buyer has 72 hours to have puppy examined by their veterinarian. If puppy is found to be ill or in poor health within 72 hours of purchase, it may be returned to the breeder for a full refund, unless the pup was neglected or abused in this time frame.
- a. This will need to come with a veterinarian detailed report.
- 12.) Buyer shall have the dog spayed/neutered within the first 11 months of age and a certificate of spay/neuter shall be provided to Tiny Paws Goldendoodles before the dog turns 12 months of age. Microchip registration will stay with Tiny Paws Goldendoodles until a spay/neuter certificate is not.
- a. If dog is bred prior to being fixed, there will be a \$2,500 fee, paid to the breeder for every puppy that is born to the dog.
- 13.) Tiny Paws Goldendoodles takes no responsibility for any veterinarian costs one buyer has possession of puppy.
- a. The buyer is responsible for all medical expenses associated with the treatment of intestinal parasites if puppy is diagnosed with them (even if puppy has parasites present when sent home).
 - i. If you are not willing to treat puppy parasites (sometimes more than one treatment is needed), then please do not buy a puppy.
 - ii. It is common for puppy parasites to flourish after joining their new family (stress and change accommodate this).
 - iii. Most parasites can be contagious and it is possible that other dogs in the house can get them.

- iv. Do not let your other dogs eat the Doodle puppy's feces and clean it up immediately using proper cleaning chemicals.
- 14.) Your puppy will come with lots of love and affection, Micro chipped, health check by certified vet, and a puppy care pack. We feed our babies Purina Pro Plan and recommend that as a food. Our puppies our part of our family even after they leave, which means we are here to support you 100% through your ownership with you puppy, we will be reachable to discuss any issues that you may have and help you through them
- 15.) The seller provides warranty against debilitating congenital defects for a period of one (2) year after the date of sale.
- a. Seller guarantees all possible steps have been taken with sire/dam selection and breeding to prevent hereditary issues.
 - b. Debilitating congenital defects are defined as those present since birth that are either life-threatening or would prevent the puppy from fulfilling the intended purpose for which it was purchased.
 - c. Any suspected debilitating congenital defect must be confirmed by a licensed veterinarian (including necropsy if patient dies).
 - i. Buyer must supply any requested veterinary records related to condition to the seller within seven days of diagnosis.
 - ii. Seller has the right to require a second opinion from a veterinarian and/or veterinary specialist of the seller's choice at the seller's expense.
 - iii. If necropsy is performed and results in undetermined or inconclusive diagnosis, warranty is void.
 - d. If congenital defect is identified within warranty period the buyer has the option to obtain a replacement puppy of equal or lesser value from the next available litter, or receive up to 50% of the cost of the reimbursed.
 - i. Original puppy need not be returned provided there is proper documentation of congenital issue.
 - ii. Breeder determines which puppy (of equal or lesser value) will be used as a replacement and the wait could be as long as 6-12 months.
 - iv. Color or gender is not guaranteed
 - v. iv. Shipping fees will not be refunded and any costs associated with shipping replacement puppy are to be covered by buyer.
 - e. If the puppy is euthanized or in any way disposed of, without a second opinion from the seller's veterinarian, the buyer waives all rights to a replacement puppy.
 - F. This warranty does not include viral illnesses, infections, improper bites, stress related illness, hernias, hypoglycemia, parasites (including Giardia or Coccidiosis), cancer or endocrine disorders. It also does not include any illness due to the ingestion of foreign objects, food, chemicals or physical injury.

- H. This warranty is non-transferable.
- I. Warranty is void if the puppy is not Spayed or Neutered by 12 months.
